**Romans 1: 9 “...that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers...”** In almost every letter of Paul, he states his priority of praying for that church. The difference about his praying for the church at Rome was that he had not been there yet. He had heard about the believers; he had received reports about the work; but at the time of this writing he had never visited them.

Our World Prayer Calendar is designed so that you can pray for fellow churches and ministries in our association and thus enable us to be more consistently praying for one another. We have included a listing of the nations of the world (some 200), that if used once a week, one can “cover the world” in a year, along with praying for every US state, every BAGBR church and pastor, and every ministry related to BAGBR. Some of these names and places you will not know but that should not be considered a barrier for praying for them, it was not for Paul. May this become a priority for every church, to put this information weekly before their people as part of their focused prayer during worship. Also, please allow this booklet to serve as a companion to your devotional material, it is for me, so that praying for the nations and the above mentioned ministries is a weekly habit of your life.

We will never know fully on this side of glory how God works in the lives of those for whom we have prayed, but we will know personally how God will begin to work inside our hearts as we consistently pray. Paul would eventually go to Rome and meet those for whom he had long prayed. God may work in your heart to one day go across the parish, nation, or even the world to see and share with those for whom you have been praying.

## A suggestion on how to use this prayer guide:

1. This guide divides the 200 nations in our world, our United States, the churches in the BAGBR Association, and the BAGBR ministries into 50 groups.
2. If you were to set aside one day of the week to pray for missions we ask that you pray for these, a different grouping of four, two/three churches of BAGBR, and one ministry and one state each week.
3. At the end of the calendar year you will have prayed one time for every country in the world, every one of the States of the US, all the churches in BAGBR, and the different ministries in BAGBR.
4. At the bottom of most pages there is space to make notes, or write impressions that you may have as you pray and meditate. There are maps at the back of the booklet as well, so that you will be able to visually see where these countries are located in our world.




