Even as I pray over the list, it is now with much more familiarity and appreciation. When I hear the names of different countries mentioned either in articles or a newscast, I am reminded again to pray for that nation, and the nations!

The psalmist said that every morning he will order his prayer before the Lord. The wording literally means to put in an organized fashion. Praying is not to be a random recall of information but rather an informed, directed, and focused time of taking things before the Lord through personal introspection and interceding on behalf of others. I do pray that you will make it a weekly habit to pray over the Nations. Take one of the 50 blocks that we have laid out in this calendar and offer up the names of the countries, the states of our nation, and the pastors and ministries of our association. May this be a habit that we do as a spiritual discipline of our life!

#### A suggestion on how to use this prayer guide:

- 1. This guide divides the 200 nations in our world, our United States, the churches in the BAGBR Association, and the BAGBR ministries into 50 groups. "People groups and unreached people groups" have been added to each country. Per the IMB peoplegroups.org website these groups are defined as follows: People group a group of people sharing a common ethnic identity and language; Unreached People Group a people group is unreached when less than two percent of its population is evangelical Christian. We have also added the freedom indicator per each country as identified by the website below. The freedom index is as follows: The ability to share the gospel in a given location: https://freedomhouse.org/report/freedom-world/freedom-world-2021
- 2. The SBC churches per state/region numbers were obtained from the 2022 Southern Baptist Convention Annual. The addition ( $\uparrow$ ) or loss ( $\downarrow$ ) of churches in that state/region are calculated from the prior year.
- 3. If you were to set aside one day of the week to pray for missions, we ask that you pray for these, a different grouping of four, one/two churches of BAGBR, and one ministry and one state each week.
- 4. At the end of the calendar year, you will have prayed one time for every country in the world, every one of the States of the US, all the churches in BAGBR, and the different ministries in BAGBR.
- 5. At the bottom of most pages there is space to make notes or write impressions that you may have as you pray and meditate. There are maps at the back of the booklet as well, so that you will be able to visually see where these countries are located in our world.
